Republican Decree No.222/2016 for the **Appointment of Ministers of the Transitional Government of National Unity of the Republic of South Sudan, 2016 A.D.**

**1. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:**

This Decree shall be cited as "The Republican Decree No.222/2016 for the **Appointment of Ministers of the Transitional Government of National Unity of the Republic of South Sudan, 2016 A.D.**" and shall come into force on the date of its signature by the President of the Republic.

**2. THE DECREE:**


In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Article 112(1) of the Transitional Constitution of the Republic of South Sudan, 2011 (as amended), read together with Chapter 1, Article 5.2.4 of the Agreement on the Resolution of the Conflict in the Republic of South Sudan, 2015, I, Salva Kiir Mayardit, President of the Republic of South Sudan, do hereby issue this Republican Decree for the **Appointment of Ministers of the Transitional**

**Government of National Unity of the Republic of South Sudan** with effect from April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016 as hereunder:


**2. THE DECREE:**
