## LAWS AND REGULATIONS

**NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**-- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1953 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

### THE DANGEROUS DRUGS REGULATIONS 1962

Made	1st December 1962
Laid before Parliament	10th December 1962
Coming into Operation	17th December 1962

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by section 9 of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1951(a)<sup>1/</sup>, I hereby make the following Regulations:

1. At the end of Schedule 5 to the Dangerous Drugs Regulations 1953(b)<sup>2/</sup> as set out in the Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Regulations 1961(c)<sup>3/</sup> (the said Schedule 5 being the Schedule which sets out the drugs to which Part III of the said Regulations of 1953 apply) there shall be added the following paragraph, that is to say:

"(g) niccocodine<sup>4/</sup> and its salts."

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs Regulations 1962 and shall come into operation on 17th December 1962.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The manufacture, sale, possession and distribution of the drugs to which Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1951 applies (that is to say the drugs specified in section 10 (1) of the Act and other drugs to which Part III has been applied

by Order in Council made under the section) are controlled by the Dangerous Drugs Regulations 1953 as subsequently amended, made under section 9 of the Act. The majority of such drugs are controlled under Part II of those Regulations, but a smaller number are subject only to less stringent control under Part III thereof. These Regulations provide for this less stringent control in the case of nicocodine and its salts, which are drugs to which Part III of the Act has been applied by the Dangerous Drugs Act 1951 (Application) Order 1962<sup>5</sup> (S.I. 1962/2349) which came into operation on 12th November 1962.
