In pursuance of sub-clause (ii) of clause (g) of section 2 of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1930 (II of 1930), and the Protocol signed at Paris on the 19th November, 1948, supplementing the Geneva Conventions of 1925, 1931 and 1936 relating to drugs placed under international control, the Central Government hereby makes the following amendment in the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) No. 4-Dangerous Drugs dated the 4th December, 1956<sup>1/</sup>, namely:

"(64) Ethyl 1-(3-cyano-3,3-diphenylpropyl)-4-phenyl-4-piperidinecarboxylate-1-(3-cyano-3,3-diphenylpropyl)-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester<sup>2/</sup> (the proposed international non-proprietary name of which is diphenoxylate)<sup>3/</sup> and its salts, preparations, admixtures, extracts and other substances containing any of these drugs."

In pursuance of sub-clause (ii) of clause (g) of section 2 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1930 (II of 1930), and the Protocol signed at Paris on the 19th November, 1948, supplementing the earlier Geneva Conventions of 1925, 1931 and 1936 relating to drugs placed under international control, the Central Government hereby declares the narcotic substances specified in the notification to be manufactured drugs and makes the following further amendment to the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) No. 4 - Dangerous Drugs dated the 4th December, 1956,<sup>1/</sup> namely:

In the said notification, after item No. (64), the following item shall be added namely:

"(65) 1-phenyl-3-(4-carbethoxy-4-phenylpiperidine)-propanol/1-(3-hydroxy-3-phenylpropyl)-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester (phenoperidine)<sup>3/</sup>/<sup>2/</sup> and its salts, preparations, admixtures, extracts and other substances containing any of these drugs."
