LETTER DATED 24 APRIL 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF JORDAN TO
THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter^{1/} of today depicting Israel's attacks on civilian targets and upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to Your Excellency's attention the following:

Today, Friday, 24 April 1970, at 0630 and consequently at 0735 hours local time Israeli jets raided civilian targets in the area of Muthalath Es-Salt and the village of Deir Alla respectively.

Five civilians were killed, among them a three-year-old boy and his nine-year-old sister and their father. Their house was destroyed. Seven others were wounded. A civilian car was destroyed and crops were burnt.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
