OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you of the following Iranian violations of the provisions of the cease-fire between Iraq and Iran:

1. During the period from 15 to 25 March 1991, the Iranian side established a presence in the central-sector area of separation with an infantry force estimated to range between a section and a platoon at the following points:
  - (a) Map of Kani: geographical coordinates 65010 and 535985;
  - (b) Map of Khanaqin: geographical coordinates 444651;
  - (c) Map of Mandali: geographical coordinates 547444, 551428, 649269, 890135, 869172, 688248, 736197, 554409, 607332, 890140, 890145, 861176 and 843186;
  - (d) Map of Baldaruz: geographical coordinates 413564.
2. At 0820 hours on 7 August 1991, a helicopter was observed coming from Sarbil Zahab in the direction of Qasr-e Shirin. It flew over the outskirts of Qasr-e Shirin and returned at 1835 hours to the Iranian rear (map of Qasr-e Shirin in the central sector).
3. At 0925 hours on 7 August 1991, a military helicopter was observed coming from the Iranian rear. It landed in the Naft Shah area at geographical coordinates 456647 (map of Khanaqin, central sector).
4. At 0800 hours on 8 August 1991, three Land Cruiser vehicles, a saloon and two pick-ups, were observed carrying 20 persons who were laying mines at coordinates 419564 in the southern-sector area of separation (map of Sheikh Faris).
5. At 0900 hours on 9 August 1991, an Iranian excavator was seen digging and improving positions at geographical coordinates 528852 in the central-sector area of separation (map of Kani Buz).
