ANNEX

Decree No. 93-2380 of 1 December 1993 concerning the creation of the Human Rights Prize of the President of the Republic of Tunisia

The President of the Republic,

Considering the Constitution, and in particular article 53 thereof, and

Having considered the opinion of the Administrative Court,

Decrees the following:

Article 1. There is instituted a prize for human rights known as the Human Rights Prize of the President of the Republic of Tunisia.

Article 2. The President of the Republic shall award the prize referred to in Article 1 to persons, organizations, institutions and bodies that have distinguished themselves by providing outstanding service in the field of human rights and their consolidation, development and promotion at the national, regional or world level.

Article 3. Decree No. 92-2142 of 10 December 1992 concerning the creation of the human rights medal of the President of the Republic is repealed.

Article 4. The present decree shall be published in the Official Journal of the Republic of Tunisia.
