AD HOC COMMISSION ON PRISONERS OF WAR

INFORMATION TRANSMITTED BY GOVERNMENTS  
CONCERNING PRISONERS OF WAR

In addition to previous replies from Governments concerning prisoners of war (reproduced in documents A/AC.46/1 and Add.1 to 7), the Secretary-General has received further replies from Governments (A/AC.46/1/Add.8 and 9) since the Ad Hoc Commission on Prisoners of War went into recess on 15 August 1951. In addition he has received the following reply from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Government of the United States of Venezuela:

VENEZUELA

Caracas, 14 August 1951

The Minister of Foreign Affairs presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to acknowledge receipt of his note No. SOA 417/5/01 of 22 June of this year requesting information under sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of General Assembly resolution 427 (V) on prisoners of war.

The Minister of Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform the Secretary-General of the United Nations that the Government of Venezuela has no information to furnish on the matter inasmuch as there are now no prisoners of war in the country. He has the honour to be, etc.
