Amendment of the Title of Item 8 of the Agenda

In its resolution on the principle of equal pay for equal work for men and women workers of 10 March 1948 (121(VI)), the Economic and Social Council transmitted the memorandum of the World Federation of Trade Unions (document E/627/Add.1) to the Commission on the Status of Women for its consideration and for any suggestions it might wish to make to the Council. Accordingly, Item 8 of the Provisional Agenda, document E/CN.6/77, was drafted as follows:

"The principle of equal pay for equal work for men and women workers. Study of the memorandum submitted by the World Federation of Trade Unions (document E/776 - Resolution 121(VI))."

At its eighth session the Economic and Social Council passed a resolution on 18 February 1949 referring the entire documentation on equal pay to the Commission on the Status of Women with the recommendation that the Commission (a) make available to the ILO any relevant material in its possession, and (b) in its own deliberations examine all relevant documents. Under these circumstances, a revision of Item 8 of the provisional agenda E/CN.6/77 appears necessary. The Secretary-General therefore submits the following text as Item 8 of the agenda:

"8. The principle of equal pay for equal work for men and women workers. (Resolution of Economic and Social Council 121(VI), and Resolution of 18 February 1949, document E/1277)."
