LETTER DATED 24 SEPTEMBER 1956 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF EGYPT  
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions from my Government and in view of further developments since my letter dated 17 September 1956 (document S/3650) concerning the Suez Canal, I have the honour to request that the Security Council be urgently convened to consider the following:

"Actions against Egypt by some powers, particularly France and the United Kingdom, which constitute a danger to international peace and security and are serious violations of the Charter of the United Nations."
