AUDIT REPORTS RELATING TO EXPENDITURE BY SPECIALIZED AGENCIES OF  
TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS ALLOCATED FROM THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 800th meeting, held on 25 November 1960, the Fifth Committee considered the agenda item entitled "Audit reports relating to expenditure by specialized agencies of technical assistance funds allocated from the Special Account". The Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General transmitting these reports (A/4422) as well as a report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/4590).

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

2. The Fifth Committee decided unanimously to recommend to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The General Assembly

Takes note of the audit reports relating to expenditure by specialized agencies of technical assistance funds allocated from the Special Account, for the financial year ended 31 December 1959,<sup>1/</sup> and of the observations thereon of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions as set forth in its twenty-sixth report to the General Assembly at its fifteenth session.<sup>2/</sup>
